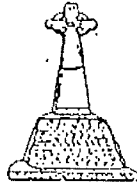

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BRYMBO COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD  
ON TUESDAY 12<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2011 AT BRYMBO ENTERPRISE CENTRE.

### 2. POLICING

Brymbo- 5 Criminal damage, 8 Rowdy nuisance juveniles and 3 Rowdy  
nuisances other.

The police sent their apologies for not being able to stay and attend the  
meeting as they were particularly busy that evening.

Cllr Rogers said that disturbances had been reported at Tanyfron Youth Club.  
It had unfortunately had to close for the week as a result of this. It seemed  
there was a minority of youths causing trouble and the previous night 3 police  
cars had to attend approx. 15 youths. Cllr Birch said that he would go and take  
a look when it re-opened to see what was happening.

### 3. CAMBRIAN HOUSE

Cllr Monti said that the laundry was now up and running, and was going well. There had been a few problems with empty valves having dried up and seeping. These would probably need new glands eventually. There was not a separate meter for electricity and did the Council wish him to get a price for this. All were in favour. Cllr Davies said that it would be beneficial to hire a caretaker for the building who could check on it for an hour in the morning and an hour at night and be available if the alarms went off. Cllr Birch said that he was willing to talk to WCBC about employing one. Cllr Monti expressed another invitation for the Councillors to take a look around the new business. He said he was particularly proud that jobs had been created in the village for local people.

### 4. COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORTS

Cllr Kelly said that issues were still unresolved on Brymbo Road by the school. He asked the Clerk to e-mail Paul Fairclough to see if anything could be done. On the issue of the remedial work at the Community Centre in Bwlchgwyn, this needed to be resolved. The Clerk would contact Geraint Smith from Enterprise to get the project underway.

Problems were still being encountered with regards to the lighting in Bwlchgwyn where Scottish Power and Manweb were undertaking work. The Clerk said she had spoken to NWP power about this and they had asked us to bear with them as the problem was larger than first thought and it could take up to 2 months to complete.

Before Cllr Rogers gave his report Cllr Birch wished him the best of luck on behalf of the Community Council, in the forthcoming Welsh Assembly Elections.

Cllr Rogers said that the traffic calming in Tanyfron was nearly complete, and improvements had been carried out on the Link Road.

With regard to the MUGA at Argoed the Clerk had been in contact with Denise Garland with regards to the costings and these were approx. £1200.00 per annum. WCBC would be bringing the MUGA up to standard at a cost of approx. £68000.00. The Clerk was to confirm that this was acceptable by the Community Council and the project could now go ahead. She would also verify that the Community Council would not need to take out insurance as it would be under the ownership of WCBC.

Cllr Rogers said that a report was expected the next day on the Housing Renewal Scheme. There were a number of options on the way forward. It was expected that Brymbo and Broughton were to be prioritised; however the scheme could be extended to 2 years. The focus would be on chimneys, roofs, gutter, facing and insulation. Any houses built after 1959 would not now be eligible for the scheme. Cllr Shone asked what would happen to the other areas of Wrexham and Cllr Rogers said that there was to be a reduction in work.

Cllr Birch said that he had noticed a very large quantity of top soil being delivered to the new play area that was being built. He was concerned about the scale of the project. Cllr Rogers said that planning had been deferred, and it now looked as though a more rounded landscape was to be built with more trees surrounding. Cllr Davies asked for an update on the Enterprise Centre,

and was told that it was doing well, with 3 directors on board and 1 more joining with another interested.

Cllr Birch asked Cllr Rogers if he could order three salt bins in preparation for the winter for Tanyfron. This would be paid from the Environmental Fund.

#### 5. ROADS

Cllr Rogers said that the road re-surfacing programme was underway and would Councillors e-mail him with any roads they thought needed attention. Cllr B Stapley has asked Cllr Rogers to either have the figure 30 M.P.H. or SLOW put on the Pool Road and Blast Road as drivers were travelling over the set speed limit. Cllr Rogers said that this was not possible due to legislation.
