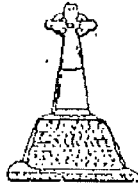

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BRYMBO COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON TUESDAY 10TH OF MAY 2011 AT BRYMBO ENTERPRISE CENTRE.

Present –Cllr K Ashton (Chairman)

Brymbo Ward- Councillors N Davies, K Monti, A Stapley, B Stapley, and H Williams.

Bwlchgywn Ward-Councillors A Roberts and B Woodfine-Jones

Tanyfron Ward Councillors-T Birch and D Griffiths.

County Borough Councillor D Kelly.

Apologies Councillors-P Rogers, M Shone, S Tilston and S Wynne

1. The minutes of the last meeting were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman. Cllr Monti requested that the Clerk minute the invitation that had been received to the Queen's garden party, which was to be attended by Cllr Birch and his wife.

2. POLICING

Apologies had been received from the Police.

No crime statistics had been received for Brymbo and Tanyfron.

Bwlchgywn-1 criminal damage and 1 theft other.

3. CAMBRIAN HOUSE

Cllr Monti said he was still waiting for a quote for the electric meter which was to be installed at Cambrian House. He said that the laundry service was doing well. There were seven units now left and it would be beneficial to advertise these as vacant. Cllr Ashton said that the sub-committee should meet to discuss rent values and discuss the way forward with the vacant units. Cllr Monti requested reimbursement for travelling expenses and telephone calls which he had made over the last few months. Cllr B Stapley said that travelling expenses had been discussed at previous meetings and Councillor's had been told that these could not be claimed. The Clerk said that perhaps a payment could be made from the Chairman's Allowance. The Clerk

was asked to investigate the matter of travelling expenses to see if a claim could be made.

4. COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORTS

Cllr Kelly said that Brymbo Road was on the County Borough's list for repairs and work should begin within 10-12 weeks. Cllr Kelly said that there was still problems with the lights in Bwlchgwyn, however the Clerk had spoken to NWP that morning who had said that new switches were now needed as the works being carried out by Manweb had been completed. The Clerk had authorised the work and had been told that the lights would be fully operational by the end of the next working day. Cllr Woodfine-Jones (lighting rep) said that he would contact NWP and Manweb to see if the cost would be met by Manweb as they had originally replaced the poles and cables.

Cllr Kelly asked if any headway had been made with regards to the re-turfing at Bwlchgwyn. The Clerk said she had spoken to Geraint Smith at Enterprise who had said that a request was to be made in writing to Paul Fairclough. This had been done and the Clerk was waiting for a reply.

Cllr Kelly said that the Bridleway application at the Flash in Bwlchgwyn had been causing unrest amongst some residents. The adjoining historic track did qualify for bridleway status, however residents were not happy as there was no right of way. Cllr Kelly said that he had received an e-mail confirming that the public had no right of way, and this was a civil matter and the Community Council and WCBC had no authority on this issue.

Cllr Rogers had telephoned the Clerk with his apologies for the meeting, however, he had received a request from the Directors of Brymbo Enterprise Centre to arrange an extraordinary meeting to discuss the Centre. The Clerk was to liaise with both parties to arrange a meeting.

5. ROADS

Cllr B Stapley said that something needed to be done with regards to speeding vehicles on Blast Toad and Pool Road. He had asked Cllr Rogers at the last meeting if 30m.p.h./SLOW could be painted on the road. He was told this was not possible, however, after making further enquiries he seemed to think that it could be done. The Clerk was to contact Highways to clarify the position.

6. BUS SHELTER SERVICES AND STOPS

Cllr Birch said that the new bus shelter had not been installed on the new estate and asked if the Clerk would follow this up with Cllr Rogers.

10. CHURCHYARDS

Cllr A Stapley said that the church car park needed clearing as on certain occasions there was not enough room for parking. He asked whether church members could do this. It was suggested that perhaps Groundwork could assist with this project. The Clerk was to make enquiries.

12. TANYFRON MUGA

Cllr Birch said that a meeting had not been arranged between the Tanyfron Councillor's and Cllr Rogers as agreed at the last meeting.

13. BWLCHGWYN OUT OF SCHOOL CLUB

The Clerk read out a letter from the above, thanking the Community Council for their grants totalling £7200.00. A request was made for further funding of £4300.00 to pay the salary of one play worker. Cllr Woodfine-Jones said that parents had to pay to use this facility unlike the Play scheme last year which was free and there was no justification for this request. Cllr Birch said that he thought the Community Council had already granted enough financially. Cllr Roberts said that the play scheme was not now going ahead and this was not a like for like scheme. It was agreed that this item was to be placed on the Agenda for the next meeting for further discussion, and an invite extended to Nicky Roberts to attend.

14.TANYFRON AND VRON COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

A request had been received from the above to pay for the installation of a new television aerial at a cost of £175.00. Financial statements had been received. It was agreed that this money would come from Tanyfron's Environmental Fund.

15 DONATIONS TO BE CONSIDERED

The request for financial assistance from St Mary's Church Brymbo to help with grass cutting was to be put on the Donations list for the next meeting.

16.BRYMBO POST OFFICE

Cllr Monti told the Community Council that the postmaster was due to retire at the end of the year, and this would leave the village without a Post Office. He asked if the Community Council could look at a way to save this vital service. Cllr Birch said that it should be looked into. A new location was needed which would have to adhere to regulations. Cllr Davies said that funding through grants could be looked at. It was agreed to put the item on the Agenda for further discussion.
