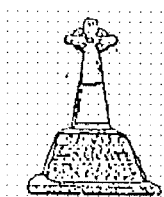

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BRYMBO COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD ON
TUESDAY FEBRUARY 10 2009 IN THE ENTERPRISE CENTRE BRYMBO.

Apologies for absence had been received from Cllrs S Wynne.

The minutes of the meeting held on 13 January 2009 were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

2. POLICING

P C Hughes gave a crime report for the month of January.

Brymbo- 1 reported incident of criminal damage, 2 of theft, 2 thefts from motor vehicle, 2 incidents of criminal damage to motor vehicles and 1 UTMV.

Tanyfron- 1 reported incident of criminal damage.

Bwlchgwyn- 2 reported assaults and 1 criminal damage to a motor vehicle.

Cllr Stapley thanked the police for their attendance at the Luncheon Club and said that the residents felt that there was a connection between them and the police and it had a positive affect all round. P C Hughes said that the caravan on Brynyffynnon Road was expected to receive a 7 day notice.

2. CAMBRIAN HOUSE

A meeting of the Sub-Committee had been held in which Cllr Davies was elected Chair. It was discussed that a brief would to be put together to engage in consultations as previously discussed at the Community Council meeting. Cllr Shone asked whether it would be an open brief and would it compliment other services in the village. Cllr Davies said that it would, and said that the next scheduled meeting would be Tuesday 10 march at a time yet to be agreed.

3. COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCILLORS REPORTS

Cllr Dave Kelly reported that due to a very cold spell WCBC were running low on grit as the salt union was not fulfilling its obligation. Salt bins were not being refilled on a national level .Cllr Woodfine Jones said that he was very impressed with the way the roads had been
